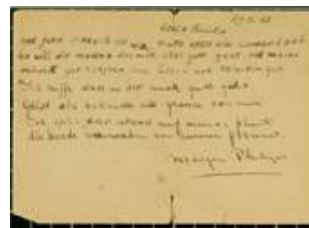


Golden wedding for Alice née Saltiel (of Lincoln, England)
