The journal's goal is to promote the history and culture of Jews, originally from the Iberian peninsula, who settled in the former Ottoman Empire, the Netherlands and the Americas.

Between 1992 and 2005, Jean Carasso published *La Lettre Sépharade* in France; in 2000, a US edition began, with quarterly reviews of books, CDs and articles in periodicals, as well as essays, articles on genealogy, poems, testimonies and a few pages in Ladino. When I edited the *Shealtiel Gazette*, Jean and I exchanged courtesy copies and I was delighted when I eventually met him in person at Philippe's house at the time of our 2003 reunion in Montpellier.
